



The Composite Sandwich of Awesomeness



Here's what we put in it:


- 1. Gel coat.
- 2. 100% vinyl ester barrier coat.
- 3. First application of chopped fiberglass.
- **4.** Second application of chopped fiberglass.
- 5. Hand-laid woven roving fiberglass.
- 6. Third application of chopped fiberglass.
